Technique workshop



Learn how to "go with the flow" and find out how relaxing free-form cutting and topstitching can be! You will create a piece of fabric with dramatic curves and angles. Karen will show you how to use your beautiful "Wiggles & Waves" fabric in traditional and contemporary quilts, impressive borders, eye-catching wearables, background for appliqué and much, much more!

| Rotary cutting supplies |
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| Iron and ironing surface |
| Large and small fabric scissors |
| Sewing machine |
| Sewing machine needles: although we are topstitching we do not need topstitch |
| needles. I recommend good sharp piecing needles, such as Jeans 70/11, Quilting |
| 75/11 or Sharps |
| Long pins |
| 6 fat quarters (18" x 22"/46cm x 56cm) of 6 values in the same color family OR 1 |
| multi-color fabric with 5 coordinating fabrics |
| Thread: Choose ONE (solid or variegated) to match all of the fabrics |
| Marking pencil or chalk (optional) |
